Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 68A, on the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 577.8 feet South and 1425.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $61^{\circ} 39'$ 483.3 feet along the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road and Lot 62 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $116^{\circ} 37'$ 462.3 feet along Lot 62 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $205^{\circ} 29'$ 1067.0 feet along the East side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $295^{\circ} 39'$ 747.3 feet along Lot 66 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $25^{\circ} 29'$ 684.0 feet along Lot 68A to the point of beginning.
