Beginning at a + on boulder at the South corner of this lot and near the East bank of the Waimea River, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 15135.3 feet North and 531.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2599, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 161° 55' 975.7 feet along near the East bank of the Waimea River;
2. 196° 49' 208.8 feet along same;
3. 218° 56' 833.5 feet along same;
4. 336° 03' 280.9 feet along government land to foot of pali;
5. 27° 49' 471.0 feet along foot of pali;
6. 32° 53' 380.2 feet along same;
7. 357° 45' 783.8 feet along same to the point of beginning.
