Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of L.C.A. ^{6450:2} to Halekahi and on the East side of Kula road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 9162.2 feet South and 10596.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 318° 10' 495.0 feet along L.C.A. ^{6450:2} to Halekahi to a mamane post;
2. 300° 27' 773.8 feet along Lot 64 to a mamane post;
3. 75° 10' 350.0 feet along L.C.A. 6720B:2 to Nahelu to a mamane post;
4. 98° 10' 257.0 feet along L.C.A. 6720B:2 to Nahelu to a mamane post;
5. 40° 10' 60.0 feet along L.C.A. 6720B:2 to Nahelu to a mamane post;
6. 311° 02' 644.0 feet along L.C.A. 6720B:2 to Nahelu;
7. 42° 11' 220.0 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
8. 34° 51' 20.0 feet along Middle road to a mamane post;
9. 129° 46' 1838.4 feet along the land of the Maui County Farm to a mamane post on the East side of Kula road;
10. Along Kula road to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being 248° 41' 804.0 feet.
