Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 63, on the East side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 709.1 feet North and 3285.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $196^{\circ} 20'$ 403.3 feet along the East side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $286^{\circ} 20'$ 1468.1 feet along Lot 76 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $25^{\circ} 29'$ 631.7 feet along the West side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $115^{\circ} 29'$ 1385.8 feet along Lot 63 to the point of beginning.
