Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 68A, on the West side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 233.3 feet South and 562.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $115^{\circ} 39'$  1377.7 feet along Lots 68A and 64 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $205^{\circ} 29'$  323.0 feet along the East side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $286^{\circ} 20'$  1070.6 feet along Lot 77 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $196^{\circ} 20'$  396.0 feet along Lot 77 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $295^{\circ} 50'$  729.0 feet along Lot 77 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
6.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  393.0 feet along North side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
7.  $24^{\circ} 42'$  715.0 feet along the West side of Kalaniai Road to the point of beginning.
