Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 67, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 2904.3 feet South and 2690.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $223^{\circ} 14' 30''$ 511.1 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $311^{\circ} 15'$ 1121.5 feet along Lot 65 to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. $31^{\circ} 56'$ 262.4 feet along the top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
4. $19^{\circ} 13'$ 197.2 feet along the top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
5. $30^{\circ} 35'$ 70.0 feet along the top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. $131^{\circ} 15'$ 1268.8 feet along Lot 67 to the point of beginning.
