Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 63 and on the East side of homestead road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Teton" is $94^{\circ} 37'$ 619.2 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaluamoa" are 3166.4 feet South and 150.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $244^{\circ} 35'$ 1552.5 feet along Lot 63 to a + on stone;
2. $18^{\circ} 01'$ 904.6 feet along Government land to a + on stone;
3. $69^{\circ} 08'$ 1060.9 feet along Lot 68 to a + on stone on the East side of homestead road;
4. $167^{\circ} 14'$ 586.5 feet along East side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
