Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 66, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 2904.3 feet South and 2690.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $311^{\circ} 15'$ 1268.8 feet along Lot 66 to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $30^{\circ} 35'$ 136.7 feet along top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
3. $64^{\circ} 37'$ 103.6 feet along top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
4. $37^{\circ} 47'$ 202.0 feet along top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
5. $32^{\circ} 59'$ 40.0 feet along top of West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
6. $131^{\circ} 15'$ 1287.1 feet along Lot 68 to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe
7. $223^{\circ} 14' 30''$ 471.0 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to the point of beginning.
