Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot marked by a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu, the coordinates of which point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-A-Ao" being 1022.2 feet North and 1766.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2477, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 250.0 feet along 30 foot road to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu at intersection of 20 foot and 30 foot roads;
2. 360° 00' 209.1 feet along 20 foot road to a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe and ahu;
3. 73° 29' 149.5 feet along 20 foot road to a 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ inch pipe and ahu about 30 feet North of mango trees;
4. 56° 05' 85.4 feet along 20 foot road to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe and ahu;
5. 90° 00' 35.9 feet along government land to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
6. 180° 00' 300.0 feet along Lot 66A to the point of beginning.
