Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 72, on the East side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 2734.7 feet South and 2352.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $202^{\circ} 53'$  394.3 feet along the East side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $270^{\circ} 00'$  295.6 feet along the South side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $180^{\circ} 00'$  433.4 feet along the East side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  1164.0 feet along Lot 70 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe on top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch;
5. Thence following along the top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $61^{\circ} 22'$  1124.6 feet;
6.  $134^{\circ} 40'$  583.1 feet along Lot 72 to the point of beginning.
