Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 73, on the Southeast side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 3940.5 feet South and 3626.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 305° 00' 1221.8 feet along Lot 73 to a 1½ inch pipe on top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch;
2. Thence following along the top of West edge of Kalopa Gulch to a 1½ inch pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being: 49° 54' 706.4 feet;
3. 125° 00' 1049.5 feet along Lot 75 to a 1½ inch pipe;
4. 215° 00' 80.0 feet along the Southeast side of Kalaniai Road to a 1½ inch pipe;
5. 180° 00' 300.6 feet along the East side of Kalaniai Road to a 1½ inch pipe;
6. 242° 00' 400.0 feet along the Southeast side of Kalaniai Road to the point of beginning.
