Anahola, Kawaihau (Koolau), Kauai, T. H.

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Anahola

Beginning at the Government Survey Triangulation Station "SOUTH BASE" said station being marked by a "+" on concrete monument and situate at an angle on the northeast boundary of this lot, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2464, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 307° 15' 164.0 feet along Government Land;
2. 26° 15' 284.9 feet along Government Land and Olokauha Road;
3. 89° 00' 66.1 feet along the northerly side of abandoned railroad right of way (30 feet wide);
4. Thence along the northerly side of the abandoned railroad right of way (30 feet wide) on a curve to the right having a radius of 701.8 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
89° 09' 55" 4.1 feet;
5. 113° 25' 162.0 feet along Lot 65, Anahola Lots;
6. 134° 33' 279.0 feet along Lot 65, Anahola Lots;
7. 199° 10' 49.2 feet along L.C.Aw. 4694 Apana 2 to Lono Elua;
8. 111° 10' 85.8 feet along L.C.Aw. 4694 Apana 2 to Lono Elua;
9. 204° 10' 56.1 feet along L.C.Aw. 4632 Apana 2 to Lono Akahi;
10. 225° 49' 306.8 feet along Government Land;
11. 316° 30' 340.0 feet along Government Land to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 4.48 Acres.
