Beginning at a + on rock at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Government Lot and on the East side of trail leading up the valley, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanikahio" being 692.3 feet South and 323.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2247, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 235° 48' 37.9 feet along the East side of trail;
2. 220° 43' 170.8 feet along same to a one-half inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 222° 26' 30" 295.1 feet along remainder of Pololu to a one-inch pipe and ahu;
4. 29° 15' 452.4 feet along the Ili of Pau to a one-inch pipe;
5. 102° 14' 123.6 feet along Government Lot to the point of beginning.
