Portion of Alamihi known as Baseball Grounds,
Alamihi, Lahaina, Maui.

Beginning at a red-wood post at the Southeast corner of this piece, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Laina" being 4740.0 feet South and 6201.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2414, and running by true azimuth

1. $97^{\circ} 45'$ 350.0 feet along L.C.A. 8515 to G.Lahilahi to a red-wood post;
2. $181^{\circ} 16'$ 135.0 feet along Government land (Papiha Cemetery) to fence corner;
3. $293^{\circ} 49'$ 75.5 feet along fence along Government land (Papiha Cemetery) to corner fence;
4. $271^{\circ} 04'$ 247.7 feet along Government land (Papiha Cemetery) to a 3x4 post;
5. $349^{\circ} 34'$ 149.6 feet along Alamihi Pond to the point of beginning.
