1. $66^{\circ} 49'$ 603.3 feet to the East side of Piliamoo Road, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Southwest corner of Lot 45, the East side of Piliamoo Road and on the North side of Kahuna Road being:
 $357^{\circ} 21'$ 110.9 feet.


