Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Lot 46, Kapaa Homesteads, 1st. Series, Puna, Kauai, the center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning on the boundary between Lots 46 and 47, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Southeast corner of Lot 46, the Southwest corner of Lot 47 and on the North side of Kahuna Road being, $8^{\circ} 14'$ 491.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $66^{\circ} 49'$ 550.4 feet to the boundary between Lots 45 and 46, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Southeast corner of Lot 45, the Southwest corner of Lot 46, and on the North side of Kahuna Road being: $1^{\circ} 23'$ 309.2 feet.
