Beginning on the boundary between Lots 48 and 53, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Northeast corner of Lot 48, and the Northwest corner of Lot 53 being, $169^{\circ} 11' 68.9$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $55^{\circ} 35'$ 574.8 feet to the boundary between Lots 47 and 48, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Northwest corner of Lot 48 and the Northeast corner of Lot 47 being: $190^{\circ} 27'$ 485.2 feet.
