Railroad Right-of-way (20 feet wide) thru Lot 53, Kapaa Homesteads, 1st. Series, Puna, Kauai, the center line of which is described as follows:-

Beginning on the North boundary of Lot 53, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Northwest corner of Lot 53 and the Northeast corner of Lot 48 being, $68^{\circ} 21'$ 238.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along a curve to the right with a radius of 230.59 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $46^{\circ} 56' 30''$ 69.3 feet;
2. $55^{\circ} 35'$ 191.7 feet to the boundary between Lots 53 and 48, the azimuth and distance to a + on stone at the Northwest corner of Lot 53 and the Northeast corner of Lot 48 being: $169^{\circ} 11'$ 68.9 feet;
