Railroad Right-of-way thru Lot 245, Kapaa
Homesteads, 4th. Series, Puna, Kauai.

Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of Lot 245 and the Southwest corner of Chinese Cemetery, the direct azimuth and distance to "Apopo" Trig. Station being $170^{\circ} 01'$ 322.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2583, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $98^{\circ} 42'$ 178.2 feet along Kapaa Rice and Kula Lot 2-A to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $100^{\circ} 20'$ 131.1 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. $111^{\circ} 25'$ 95.0 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. $282^{\circ} 13'$ 402.7 feet to the point of beginning.
