Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 13, which is also the Southwest corner of this piece, the true azimuth and distance from the "Concrete Post" which marks the Southwest corner of Lot 12 being: 290° 52' 1711.7 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 205° 43' 4873.0 feet along Lot 13;
2. 29° 20' 155.0 feet;
3. 328° 31' 164.0 feet along fifty foot road;
4. 25° 43' 4625.0 feet along Lot 14;
5. 110° 52' 200.0 feet to the initial point.
