Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 15, which is also the Southwest corner of this piece, the true azimuth and distance from the "Concrete Post" which marks the Southwest corner of Lot 12 being: $290^{\circ} 52'$ 4140 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $202^{\circ} 50'$ 4102.0 feet along Lot 15 to road;
2. $291^{\circ} 25'$ 199.8 feet;
3. $22^{\circ} 50'$ 4100.0 feet along Lot 16;
4. $110^{\circ} 52'$ 200.0 feet to the initial point;
