Reserve between Lot 17 and Lot 18.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of this piece which is also the Southwest corner of Lot 18, the true azimuth and distance from "Concrete Post" which marks the Southeast corner of Lot 21A being $110^{\circ} 52'$ 4889 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318 and running by true azimuths:-

1. $110^{\circ} 52'$ 202.0 feet along Government Land to Southeast corner of Lot 17;
2. $197^{\circ} 10'$ 2452.0 feet along Lot 17 to road;
3. Thence along the South side of 50 foot road to the Northeast corner of Lot 18, the true azimuth and distance being:-
 $307^{\circ} 35'$ 215.0 feet;
4. $17^{\circ} 10'$ 2390.0 feet along Lot 18 to the initial point.
