Reserve between Lot 18 and Lot 19.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of this piece, which is also the Southwest corner of Lot 19, the true azimuth and distance from "Concrete Post" which marks the Southeast corner of Lot 21A being $110^{\circ} 52'$ 3381.0 feet as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $110^{\circ} 52'$ 200.0 feet along Government Land to Southeast corner of Lot 18;
2. $196^{\circ} 27'$ 2672.0 feet along Lot 18 to road;
3. $270^{\circ} 02'$ 205.0 feet along 50 foot road to the Northwest corner of Lot 19;
4. $16^{\circ} 27'$ 2740.0 feet along Lot 19 to the initial point.
