Reserve between Lot 19 and Lot 20.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of this piece, which is also the Southwest corner of Lot 20 the true azimuth and distance from "Concrete Post" which marks the Southeast corner of Lot 21A being $110^{\circ} 52' 2268.0$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $110^{\circ} 52'$ 200.0 feet along Government to Southeast corner of Lot 19;
2. $204^{\circ} 56'$ 2973 feet along Lot 19 to road;
3. $265^{\circ} 54'$ 230.0 feet along 50 foot road to the Northwest corner of Lot 20;
4. $24^{\circ} 56'$ 3074.0 feet along Lot 20 to the initial point.
