Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 27, which is also the Northwest corner of this piece, the true azimuth and distance from the new Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapualei" being: $316^{\circ} 29'$ 1460 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $301^{\circ} 15'$ 206.0 feet;
2. $17^{\circ} 09'$ 3289.0 feet along Lot 25 to fifty foot road;
3. $58^{\circ} 45'$ 76.5 feet along fifty foot road;
4. $143^{\circ} 45'$ 164.5 feet along fifty foot road;
5. $197^{\circ} 09'$ 3286.0 feet along Lots 26 and 27 to the initial point.
