Reserve between Lot 25 and Lot 27.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 27, which is also the Northwest corner of this piece, the true azimuth and distance from the new Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapualei" being $316^{\circ} 29'$ 1460 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $301^{\circ} 15'$ 206 feet;
2. $17^{\circ} 09'$ 1525 feet along Lot 25;
3. $115^{\circ} 20'$ 202 feet along Government Land to the Southeast corner of Lot 27;
4. $197^{\circ} 09'$ 1546 feet along Lot 27 to the initial point.
