Paauiilo Homesteads, Hamakua, Hawaii.

Reserve running through Lot 15  
and adjoining Lot 14.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 14, which is also the Southwest corner of this piece, the true azimuth and distance from the "Concrete Post" which marks the Southwest corner of Lot 12 being:  $290^{\circ} 52'$  2984 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2318, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $204^{\circ} 36'$  2055.0 feet along Lot 14;
2.  $250^{\circ} 07'$  445.0 feet through Lot 15;
3.  $242^{\circ} 00'$  265.0 feet through Lot 15;
4.  $245^{\circ} 25'$  301.0 feet through Lot 15;
5.  $242^{\circ} 00'$  273.0 feet through Lot 15;
6.  $253^{\circ} 27'$  446.0 feet through Lot 15 to the line of the boundary of Lot 15;
7.  $22^{\circ} 50'$  448.0 feet along reserve;
8. Thence along bottom of gulch to a point on the East boundary of this piece in said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $65^{\circ} 20'$  1350 feet;
9.  $24^{\circ} 36'$  1930.0 feet along Lot 15;
10.  $110^{\circ} 52'$  191.5 feet to the initial point.
