Anahola, Koolau, Kauai

Beginning at the Southwest corner of this Lot, and at the Northeast corner of Kou and Ohia Roads, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "South Base" (Anahola Survey) being 520.7 feet South and 345.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2464 and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:

1. 165° 52' 145.5 feet along the East side of Ohia Road (40 feet wide);
2. 269° 00' 102.7 feet along the South side of Lihue Plantation Company's Railroad Right-of-way (30 feet wide);
3. 345° 52' 122.2 feet along the remaining portion of Anahola Park (Executive Order 478);
4. 75° 52' 100.0 feet along the North side of Kou Road (40 feet wide) to the point of beginning.
