Beginning at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 1 and on the North side of Beretania Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly with the center line of Lusitana Street, being 334.86 feet South and 437.10 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Thence on a curve to the right along the North side of Beretania Avenue with a radius of ~~1369.58~~ ^{1237.16} feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 117° 10' 40" 102.5 feet;
2. 226° 30' 30" 118.4 feet along Lot 3;
3. 327° 15' 28.7 feet along Lot 4;
4. 293° 31' 30" 32.2 feet along Lot 4;
5. 23° 31' 30" 99.65 feet along Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
