Beginning at the West corner of this lot, and on the East corner of Beretania Avenue and Lisbon Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly with the center line of Lusitana Street, being 239.84 feet South and 605.19 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 237° 15' 155.0 feet along Lisbon Street;
2. 327° 15' 60.0 feet along Lot 4;
3. 46° 30' 30" 118.4 feet along Lot 2;
4. Thence along Beretania Avenue with a curve to the right and with a radius of ~~1369.58~~ feet, the direct^{1237.16 *} azimuth and distance being 122° 01' 90.7 feet to the point of beginning.
