1. $123^{\circ} 55'$ 118.4 feet along North side of Beretania Avenue;
2. $38^{\circ} 02'$ 116.9 feet along fence;
3. $327^{\circ} 15'$ 107.12 feet along Lot 2;
4. $57^{\circ} 15'$ 70.0 feet along Lisbon Street to the point of beginning
