Beginning at the East corner of this lot, and the West corner of Lisbon and Lusitana Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly with the center line of Lusitana Street, being 127.84 feet North and 107.51 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 57° 15' 84.71 feet along Lisbon Street;
2. 147° 15' 108.52 feet along Lot 7;
3. 235° 40' 93.55 feet along fence;
4. Thence on a curve to the left along the West side of Lusitana Street with a radius of 603.7 feet, and for a distance of 60.41 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 333° 07' 30" 60.38 feet
5. 330° 15' 30" 51.10 feet along Lusitana Street to the point of beginning.
