Beginning at a stake at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 3 and on the East side of Lusitana Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Street Monument in the center of Lusitana Street and on the Northwest line of Alapai Street running Northeasterly being 198.24 feet North and 78.71 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $150^{\circ} 15' 30''$ ~~4.27~~^{4.29} feet along Lusitana Street to a + on step;
2. Along Lusitana Street on a curve to the right with a radius of 543.7 feet to a stake, the direct azimuth and distance being ~~$155^{\circ} 02'$ 78.65~~ ^{$154^{\circ} 23'$ 78.28} feet;
3. $225^{\circ} 03'$ ~~109.6~~^{110.6} feet along Lot 5 to a stake;
4. $315^{\circ} 03'$ 78.0 feet along Lot 6 to a stake;
5. $45^{\circ} 03'$ 137.62 feet along Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
