1. 315° 03' 78.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue to a stake;
2. 45° 03' 120.0 feet along Lot 12 to a stake;
3. 135° 03' 78.0 feet along Lot 9 to a stake;
4. 325° 03' 120.0 feet along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.
