1. 251° 34' 30" 44.33 feet along Lot 5 to a stake;
2. 225° 03' 44.33 feet along Lot 5 to a stake;
3. 315° 03' 72.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue to a stake;
4. 45° 03' 61.3 feet along Lot 7 to a stake;
5. 71° 34' 30" 61.3 feet along Lot 4 to a stake;
6. 161° 34' 30" 72.0 feet along Lusitana Street to the point of beginning.
