1. 315° 05' 90.0 feet along Captain Cook Avenue to a stake
2. 45° 03' 106.08 feet along Lot 9 to a stake;
3. 148° 19' 92.47 feet along Lot 3 to a stake;
4. 225° ⁰³ ~~30~~' 84.87 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.
