Beginning at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 2 and on the North side of Captain Cook Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 440.10 feet North and 396.94 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument on the Northwest line of Alapai Street and at the intersection of the center line of Magellan and Captain Cook Avenues, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 135° 03' 91.70 feet along the North side of Captain Cook Avenue;
2. Thence on a curve to the right of a radius of 10 feet and for a distance of 20.44 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 194° 05' 45" 17.15 feet;
3. 253° 08' 30" 133.62 feet along the South side of Frear Street;
4. 343° 08' 30" 20.35 feet along Lot 8;
5. 329° 05' 45" 20.26 feet along Lot 8;
6. 45° 03' 118.10 feet along <sup>Lot</sup> 2 to the point of beginning.
