

1. $73^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 153.29 feet along Lot 8;
2. $163^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 65.0 feet along Lots 4 and 5;
3. $253^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 131.46 feet along Lot 6;
4. $324^{\circ} 34' 30''$ 68.57 feet along the Southwest side of Iolani Avenue to the point of beginning.
