Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 7 and on the Southwest side of Iolani Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 868.14 feet North and 168.63 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument on the Northwest line of Alapai Street and at the intersection of the center lines of Magallen and Captain Cook Avenues, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $324^{\circ} 34' 30''$ 49.91 feet along Southwest side of Iolani Avenue;
2. Thence on a curve to the right of a radius of 10 feet and for a distance of 18.95 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $18^{\circ} 51' 30''$ 16.24 feet;
3. $73^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 159.70 feet along the North side of Frear Street;
- * 4. $\frac{163^{\circ} 08' 30''}{163^{\circ} 0' 30''}$ 60.50 feet along Lot 4;
5. $253^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 153.29 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.
