Beginning at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 7 and on the North side of Pioneer Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 1525.06 feet North and 594.50 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument on the Northwest line of Alapai Street, and at the intersection of the centerlines of Magellan and Captain Cook Avenues, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $73^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 130.03 feet along the North side of Pioneer Street;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $131^{\circ} 11' 16.97$ feet.
3. $189^{\circ} 13'$ 118.97 feet along the East side of Lusitana Street;
4. $279^{\circ} 13'$ 96.55 feet along Lot 5;
5. $343^{\circ} 08' 30''$ 78.82 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.
