Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 1 and on the North side of *Perry Street*, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 20.95 feet North and 330.83 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument near School Street and at the intersection of the center line of Iolani Avenue, the West side of Magellan Avenue and the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 210° 58' 104.75 feet along Lot 1;
2. 300° 58' 70.40 feet along the Southwest side of Kamamalu Avenue;
3. Thence along the West side of Kamamalu Avenue on a curve to the right with a radius of 40 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 359° 11' 30" 68.0 feet;
4. Thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 19.34 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 75° 47' 12.18 feet;
5. 94° 09' 33.6 feet along the North side of Perry Street;
6. Thence along Perry Street on a curve to the right with a radius of 260.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 102° 03' 71.5 feet to the point of beginning.
