Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and on the West side of Prospect Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 691.19 feet South and 528.92 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near Puowaina Drive, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $4^{\circ} 05'$ 5.75 feet along Prospect Avenue;
2. Thence on a curve to the left along Prospect Avenue with a radius of 230.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $356^{\circ} 56' 30''$ 57.21 feet;
3. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $41^{\circ} 58' 30''$ 15.80 feet;
4. $94^{\circ} 09'$ 141.26 feet along Perry Street;
5. $184^{\circ} 09'$ 75.00 feet along Lot 10;
6. $274^{\circ} 09'$ 143.75 feet along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.
