Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 10 and on the Southeast side of Lusitana Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 276.78 feet North and 86.53 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument near School Street and at the intersection of the center line of Iolani Avenue and the West side of Magellan Avenue and the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $191^{\circ} 35'$ 27.5 feet along the Southeast side of Lusitana Street;
2. Thence along the Southeast side of Lusitana Street on a curve to the right having a radius of 543.7 feet the direct azimuth and distance being $193^{\circ} 34' 37.6$ feet;
3. $286^{\circ} 57'$ 182.95 feet along Lot 8;
4. Thence along the West side of Kahanamalu Avenue on a curve to the left with a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $15^{\circ} 05' 45.56$ feet;
5. $100^{\circ} 47'$ 180.7 feet, along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.
