Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 9 and on the Southeast side of Lusitana Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 276.78 feet North and 86.53 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument near School Street and at the intersection of the center line of Iolani Avenue, the West side of Magellan Avenue and the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $280^{\circ} 47'$ 180.7 feet along Lot 9;
2. Thence along the West side of Kamamalu Avenue on a curve to the left having a radius of 100 feet, the direct azimuth and distance of the chord being $341^{\circ} 05'$ 71.12 feet;
3. $99^{\circ} 56'$ 216.85 feet along Lots 12 and 11;
4. $191^{\circ} 35'$ 65.0 feet along the Southeast side of Lusitana Street to the point of beginning.
