Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 3 and on the West side of San Antonio Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 584.94 feet South and 33.20 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near San Antonio Avenue, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 97° 00' 62.46 feet along Lot 3;
2. 133° 39' 68.11 feet along Lot 2;
3. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 329.26 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 241° 34' 30" 65.88 feet;
4. 247° 19' 55.80 feet along Puowaina Drive;
5. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 307° 09' 30" 17.30 feet;
6. 7° 00' 97.79 feet along San Antonio Avenue to the point of beginning.
