

Beginning at the North corner of this lot and on the South side of Puowaina Drive and the Government Reserve, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 309.55 feet South and 531.16 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near San Antonio Avenue, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $337^{\circ} 45'$ 55.86 feet along the Government Reserve;
2. Thence along Prospect Avenue on a curve to the left with a radius of 229.67 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $55^{\circ} 47'$ 95.24 feet;
3. $43^{\circ} 49'$ 82.13 feet along Prospect Avenue;
4. Thence along Lot 1 on a curve to the left with a radius of 250.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $207^{\circ} 06' 30''$ 143.73 feet;
5. Thence along Lot 1 on a curve to the left with a radius of 10.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $129^{\circ} 04' 30''$ 17.55 feet;
6. $247^{\circ} 45'$ 67.56 feet along Puowaina Drive to the point of beginning.
