- Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 1 and on the South side of Puowaina Drive, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 377.75 feet South and ^{363.42}~~364.42~~ feet East of a ^{HY}_{June 27/12} Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street near San Antonio Avenue, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths
1. 337° 45' 113.45 feet along Lot 1;
 2. Thence on a curve to the right along Prospect Avenue with a radius of 120.0 feet and for a distance of 76.22 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being ~~56° 06'~~ 74.95 feet; ^{68° 06'} *
 3. 160° 15' 113.94 feet along Lot 3; ^(68-06 R.O.C.)
 4. Thence on a curve to the left along Puowaina Drive with a radius of 471.7 feet and for a distance of 28.25 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 249° 28' 28.23 feet;
 5. 247° 45' 41.77 feet along Puowaina Drive to the point of beginning.
