Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 17 and on the South side of Auwailimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 62.66 feet South and 558.46 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 282° 13' 70.00 feet along the South side of Auwailimu Street.
2. 12° 13' 75.00 feet along Lot 19;
3. 337° 45' 38.14 feet along Lot 19;
4. 56° 40' 64.74 feet along the Northwest side of Whiting Street;
5. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 310.44 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 57° 11' 5.67 feet;
6. 157° 45' 74.63 feet along Lot 16;
7. 192° 13' 95.14 feet along Lot 17 to the point of beginning.
