Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 18 and on the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 77.47 feet South and 626.87 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 282° 13' 102.18 feet along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 10.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 349° 26' 30" 18.44 feet;
3. 56° 40' 125.29 feet along the Northwest side of Whiting Street;
4. 157° 45' 38.14 feet along Lot 18;
5. 192° 13' 75.00 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
