Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 5 and on the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 102.50 feet South and 970.03 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:*

1. Along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street on a curve to the right with a radius of 280.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $269^{\circ} 12' 30''$ 80.14 feet;
2. $355^{\circ} 50'$ 156.07 feet along ~~the~~ government land;
3. $98^{\circ} 20'$ 81.94 feet along Lot 7;
4. $175^{\circ} 50'$ 143.05 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning.
